The Holiday Inn Leicester has substantially reduced its maintenance and labour costs by fitting AquaVantage systems on to their incoming rising main and open circuit hot water system.

The hotel had used an old Simplex water-softening unit to treat their hard water. The water softener required the hotel's water system to be shut off between 2.00am and 4.00am every night in order for the unit to regenerate. During this period, untreated water poured into the storage tanks so as to maintain the hotel's water supply, which neutralised the effects of the softener and, due to the plumbing arrangements, often caused flooding. Since AquaVantage systems were fitted to the 28mm copper hot return pipe to the calorifier and the 65mm incoming rising main, no further problems have been reported. The Holiday Inn Leicester estimate that the systems will save them up to £3,000 pa in just salt alone. Savings in water costs and maintenance will easily exceed this figure.
