The EndoCube reduces energy consumption on commercial refrigerators and freezers from 10% to 30% and reduces compressor cycles by up to 85% helping to prolong the life of the refrigeration equipment and reduces carbon dioxide emissions.

An EndoCube trial was conducted at the South Willow Street location. The temperature and compressor usage before and after the installation of the EndoCube were recorded and the results demonstrated a significant impact.
